Minutes for January 19, 2011

Mary Litfin, President, called the January 19, 2011 meeting of Quail Creek Lady Putters to order. - 8. Ruth converted the membership list into an Excel spreadsheet and imported it to her e-mail program. She will periodically send information via an e-mail. - 10. Set up reminder that only two holes can start off the green. These should be at least 6 inches back from the edge. All other holes should be at least 6 inches inside the edge trying to avoid crossovers and out of sequence holes.
- 10. Gift Cards-All putters who putted at least 4 out of the 5 times plus paid and attended the luncheon. Cards were distributed to those who earned them.
