

QC Putters' Minutes
Luncheon Meeting October 26, 2011

President Ruth Maki called the October 26, 2011 meeting of Quail Creek Lady Putters to order. The minutes from the August 24, 2011 were presented.

The Treasurer's report, presented by Kay Davison, showed cash on hand at the end of July of \$2,059.95.

Our old business update was made as follows:

- Rally for the Cure was held on October 20th. It was a great success. Putters made \$4900 on the raffle. QCLGA cleared \$13,004 for all events. Last year we made \$13,002 with association contributions. Ruth expressed her deep appreciation for the months of effort given by the Donation Committee (Beverly Hiatt, Mary Hughes, Bea Swiek, Gloria Clancy, Yvonne LaBec, and Jeane Hostetler). She also thanked the Basket Committee (Jan Agner, Peggy Kimes, Patty Kozma, Sharon Paxon, Vicky Mahr) and the Putter Committee (Mary Litfin, Janet Mathis, Pat Roselund, Yoshi Hennessey, Joan Harrison, Pene Williams) as well as the raffle ticket sellers (Neila Kozel, Lois Williams, Mary Cesario, Frieda Hyles, Peggy McGee, Jeane Hostetler, Lou Moultrie, Nancy McDonald, Dorene Sims, and Daryl Laux).
- As a heads up, it looks like next year the Putters will handle the food, decorations, and survivor presentation. We will likely alternate between the Raffle and the luncheon from year to year. We will not do the Golf events. Most of us just putt, but do not golf.
- Mountain View event will be here on November 16. Pat Roselund is chairing the committee. The committee is requesting that Putter's donate prizes suggesting new items that could be re-gifted.
- The Pro shop is handling the entire shirt order. The first order was already received. Shirts are available for you to try on so you get the right size. Dottie can help you. There are two clipboards.
 - Clipboard 1 - Three different shirt styles: 3/4 sleeve polo from Port Authority; short sleeve polo from Port Authority; or a sleeveless polo from Monterey Bay.
 - Clipboard 2 - Two different outer garments: Sleeveless fleece vest from Port Authority or a fleece jacket from Port Authority.

- December 1st is the new Putter/Niner/18-Holer Event. Fill out form and submit it to Pro Shop. Cost for Putters is \$17.50. This is a golf event with a team of a Niner, an 18-Holer, and one or two putters. It will be an early morning event followed by a luncheon.
- The question additional benches and/or shade was raised with Ron Darrah. After January 1st, Robson will look into the possibility of buying two more benches for the putting area. The question of shade is much more difficult. At this time if the group would like to purchase portable shade and set it up and take it down on putting days, that would work. Ron has requested information from other Robson communities concerning shade around their putting green areas. There apparently is no opportunity to add trees to that area. Some of our ladies were wondering if we pay for a tree or 2, would they do it? Ruth will inquire further.
